

OneSteel Manufacturing Community Support Guidelines

Application Guidelines

The OneSteel Manufacturing (OneSteel) Community Support Program supports initiatives that deliver social and economic benefits to the key communities in which we operate, including **Whyalla, Iron Knob & Ardrossan**.

This program provides a streamlined approach to assisting local community groups, organisations, and clubs in delivering programs, projects, and events that foster inclusion, participation, and reflect OneSteel's values.

Focus Categories

Funding is available for programs, projects, and events that align with one or more of the following categories:

- Disadvantaged
- Education & Learning
- Indigenous
- Community Events
- Diversity & Inclusion
- Youth -Sports/Arts/Development

Funding Rounds

The Community Support Program operates in two funding rounds each financial year:

Round 1- Opens 1 August - Closes 31 August

Round 2- Opens 1 February - Closes 28 February.

Application Process

- Applications must be submitted using the online application form, available on the OneSteel website.
- Letters of requests or sponsorship proposals will not be accepted.
- The application must be completed by a member of the organisation's executive committee or authorised representative.
- Applications received after the closing date will not be considered.
- The Community & Stakeholder team will review all applications based on the assessment criteria, and make recommendations to the Managing Directors of OneSteel for approval.

Assessment Process

Once the funding round closes:

- You will receive an email confirming receipt of your application.
- The Community & Stakeholder Team will review applications for eligibility. Ineligible applicants will be notified.
- Eligible applications will be assessed and approved or declined by OneSteel's Managing Director's.
- All applicants will receive an email advising the outcome within two weeks of the decision.

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Assessment Criteria

The Community Support Program is a competitive process, and OneSteel often receives more applications than it can fund. Successful applications are those that best meet the assessment criteria.

Funding will not be provided for:

- Gift vouchers, gifts, prizes, trophies, donations, air travel or accommodation.
- Operating expenses such as rent, insurance, electricity, water, or rates.
- Purchase or leasing of vehicles, trailers, and accessories
- Individual or sporting organisations uniforms, shoes, or individual equipment (e.g., mouthguards).

Terms & Conditions

- One application per organisation financial year.
- Grants will not support retrospective projects or events. Your project or event must not commence prior to receiving formal written approval.
- Programs, projects, or events must be delivered within 12 months of receipt of the funds.
- Any variation to the approved project must be agreed to in writing by the Community & Stakeholder team.
- Applicants must submit a Post-Event/Project Report using the online form, available on the OneSteel Website within 6 weeks of an event and prior to applying for future funding.
- Organisations with an outstanding report will not be eligible for further funding.
